PLANO, Texas--(BUSINESS WIRE)--Jun. 26, 2014-- Rent-A-Center today donated \$114,509.60 to North Texas Food Bank (NTFB). The proceeds are a result of a week-long fundraiser by Rent-A-Center employees coupled with a \$50,000 corporate donation.
